Date and time of random selection of precincts:  
**June 5, 2008, at 9:00 a.m.**

Method used for random selection of 1% precincts:  
**Each consolidated precinct was typed on a piece of paper and put into a container from which members of the manual recount board would draw. Precincts were drawn until all races were included in recount selection.**

Method used for additional precincts selected at the discretion of the elections official, as required by EC 15360(a), for races not included in initial group of precincts selected for the 1% manual tally: **Recount board members rolled dice to randomly select two Central Count decks of VBM ballots.**

Was random selection of precincts conducted after completion of semi-final canvass results?  
**Yes.**

Dates and times of manual tally:  
**June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except for lunches and breaks.**

Ballot types (optical scan, voter verified paper audit trail (VVPAT):  
**Humboldt County uses Premier optical scan units as its primary voting system. HART Intercivic eSlates are used for voters with disabilities. Humboldt County does not use the HART Tally system to count votes cast on the eSlate. Votes cast on the eSlate are duplicated onto Premier ballots and are counted in the official canvass.**

If the jurisdiction used direct recording electronic (DRE) voting machines, were VVPAT rolls cut or left intact?  
**Not applicable.**

What was the total number of each of the following categories of ballots?

How many people were used for each manual tally team and the roles of each person (e.g., announcer, manager, observer, checker, tallier, etc.)? **Four team members per board consisting of one announcer, one observer, and two members who tallied results.**
