RE: PEMT and 1% Manual Tally Report – May 19, 2009 Statewide Special Election


Attached is the report of the results of the 1% manual tally for Sacramento County. This tally included 10 precincts. In addition, staff performed a 100% manual tally on 4 precincts where the M100 units failed after ballots had been cast, as required by the ES&S use procedures.

The results show that 9 of the 10 1% manual tally precincts and 1 of the 4 100% manual tally precincts matched the election night results. The remaining 4 precincts showed discrepancies between the election night results and the manual tallies. Ballots from these precincts were re-tallied on the M650 unit and all totals matched the manual tallies, with the exception of Precinct 37108. Precinct 37108 has one variance in Proposition 1C, which cannot be resolved. This difference does not change the results for this contest.

Sacramento County had no contests that qualified for a PEMT.
