Report of 1 Percent Manual Tally
June 8, 2010 Consolidated Primary Election

Per California Elections Code Section 15360, 1% of precincts must be hand tallied to determine the voting system is reading and tabulating votes correctly. To determine 1% of the voting precincts, divide the total number of voting precincts, by 100. For the above stated election, there were 129 precincts, which mean that 1.29 or 2 voting precincts must be fully counted. Additionally, one precinct must be hand counted for each contest that was not included in the initial count. All precincts are randomly selected by draw. For the June 8, 2010 Primary Election the manual tally consisted of a random draw of 1% of the precincts in each supervisor district. This hand tally represents ballots cast on the touch screen, optical scan paper at the polls, and vote by mail for all races and propositions. We also performed a random draw of 1% of the mailed ballot precincts with all races and propositions counted. In addition, one additional precinct for ballots cast on the optical scan poll ballot was fully counted in Supervisor District 2.

Precinct 1810, Full Count on all contests

Optical Scan Vote by Mail & Poll and Touch Screen Ballots: Balanced on first pass.

Precinct 2804, Full Count on all contests

Optical Scan Vote by Mail & Poll and Touch Screen Ballots: Balanced on first pass.

Precinct 3218, Full Count on all contests

Optical Scan Vote by Mail & Poll and Touch Screen Ballots: Balanced on first pass. Manual tally board read 1 more vote than the card reader for Member, State Assembly, 3rd District Republican. It was determined that ballot was marked with a light penciled oval that was not seen by the reader.

Precinct 4806, Full Count on all contests

Optical Scan Vote by Mail & Poll and Touch Screen Ballots: Balanced on first pass.

Precinct 5511, Full Count on all contests

Optical Scan Vote by Mail & Poll and Touch Screen Ballots: Balanced on first pass. Manual tally board read 1 more vote than the card reader for U.S. Representative, 2nd Congressional District Democratic. It was determined that ballot was a marked with light penciled oval that was not seen by the reader.


Precinct 5904, Full Count on all contests
