On Thursday, February 27, 2026, the California Secretary of State Office of Voting Systems Technology Assessment (OVSTA) received requests for administrative approval for two (2) modifications to the Voting System for All People (VSAP) 4.0 voting system pursuant to California Elections Code section 19216. The modifications are as follows:

Type	Description
Update	Replacement network switch (Cisco N9k-C93108TC-FX3P) for Tally COTS
Update	Replacement network switch (Cisco N9K-C9336C-FX2) for Tally Fabric Extender Switch COTS

California Elections Code section 19216 precludes a voting system or part of a voting system that has been approved by the Secretary of State from being changed or modified until the Secretary of State has determined the change “does not impair its accuracy and efficiency....”

If the Secretary of State determines whether the change or modification does not impair the accuracy or efficiency of the voting system, the Secretary of State may administratively approve the proposed change or modification.

In addition, you submitted the following documents from SLI Compliance:

Based on the application, and supporting documentation from SLI Compliance, this administrative approval is granted. All other conditions of the Voting System for All People (VSAP) 4.0 certification, dated March 11, 2026, remain in effect.
